

Have a follow-up plan; a repeat meet or an invitation to the next Home Group, Church Service, etc. Do as occasion serve you. The Holy Spirit is upon you.

Things to keep at home/handy and give out when appropriate:

Pick up these items from the Information Desk or from Home Group venue - tracts, bibles, church biz cards, bulletins, and event flyers.

New Convert Slip: A smart slip with few words, quick and easy to complete on your own after the meet, to avoid forgetting their name/contact detail.

Otherwise, complete the slip just at the end of your discussion, letting them know that this slip enables you/home group/church to keep praying for them, and to keep in touch for further spiritual help. Use which ever approach you are comfortable with.

Biblical Vision For Home Groups

Acts 2:42-47

42: They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

43: Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles.

44: All the believers were together and had everything in common.

45: Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need.

46: Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts,

47: praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

Activities For FRCC Home Groups

- Fellowship around the Coffee table or sharing a meal/hospitality or recreation together.
- Bible study/teaching
- Prayer & support to meet needs of individuals, family and friends
- Discipleship roundtable/outreaches
- Meeting together with others for a larger fellowship, worship or the Lord's supper as part of the main church/weekly Services or regular events, or as part of

weekly extension Services or regular events.

Home Group Activity/Event

The First Round/Week/Month: Discipleship Roundtable

Bible topic for discussion –

Raising a Disciple for Christ one-on-one: biblical examples, personal experiences, and testimonies.

Note: Each one will be expected to apply the wisdom gleaned from the above discussions to the following activity at the next Home Group event as follows –

The Second Round/Week/Month: Raise a Disciple for Christ Through 'My Discipleship Roundtable'

To reach out to a neighbour(s) for a brief chat, or make a phone call and arrange for a day you can have coffee together. Call this day 'My Discipleship Roundtable' or My DRT Day. How you can do this -

Start today praying for people in your neighbourhood,

that God would soften their hearts and prepare them by His Spirit to come into His kingdom. For now is the time to bring them back to their God & Saviour. Time is running out!

Watch out for that defining moment or opportunity to connect with any of them. Go out of your way (for the Lord's sake) to start a greeting, a casual talk or a good joke, or be a helping hand with a random act of love and kindness that gets their attention.

Casually start a conversation

right there (chances are that your mission gets accomplished at this stage!), **or invite them over for a cup of coffee** or to a coffee shop in the neighbourhood. A meal is an option only if and when convenient to you. No pressures.

An appointment for Coffee/tea should be for the next DRT day or other days agreed in your Home group

Get to know them and enjoy a conversation; being mindful of their interests and spiritual needs.

Watch out for that moment or time that you can gently be a blessing to their need and aspirations (by a word of comfort, encouragement, prayer or counsel, or even expressions of goodwill, support, appreciation, or complement).

Always remember: It is you who initiated the contact/conversation. Never let your guests lead the conversation into other subjects or to a point where you cannot fulfil the vision of your mission to them.

Be smart to re-direct or change the course of a discussion, if it is not going down the path of your vision.
